- Entry fee:** 50 EURO per event/race to be paid in cash at the registration.

- There will be free coffee, tea as well as mineral water for all drivers during the whole weekend to be picked up in the catering area.

All cars/motors must be off use from 21.00 in the evening until 08.00 in the morning.
The drivers can be taken in for alcohol control at any time of the race.
